



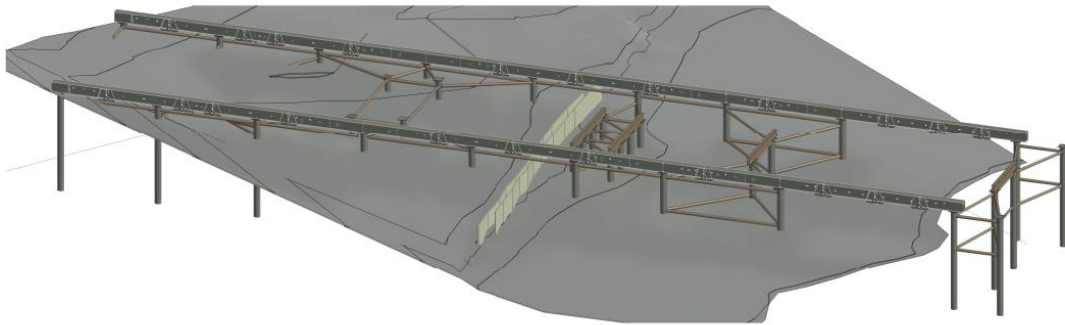

Warrenpoint Harbour hereby gives notice of the following bridge construction in Carlingford lough.

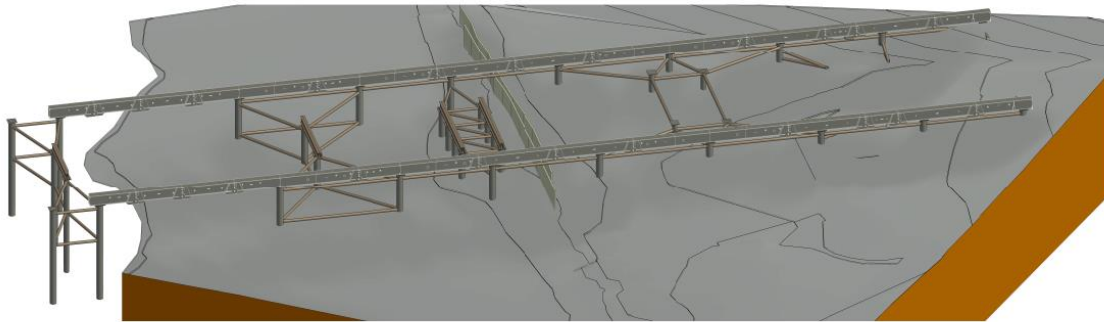
The contractors advise that On the 18/5/26 they are going to start to fit the cross bracing and pile caps to the piles south of the concrete intermediate pier. From the end of May, we will have a large 650ton crane at the south abutment to lift the steel work into position and all marine traffic should only pass through the main channel area between the fender piles. This work will be ongoing until the end of June 2026.

The channel is open and has been marked with port and starboard lights on the piles marking the navigation channel for your safety.
